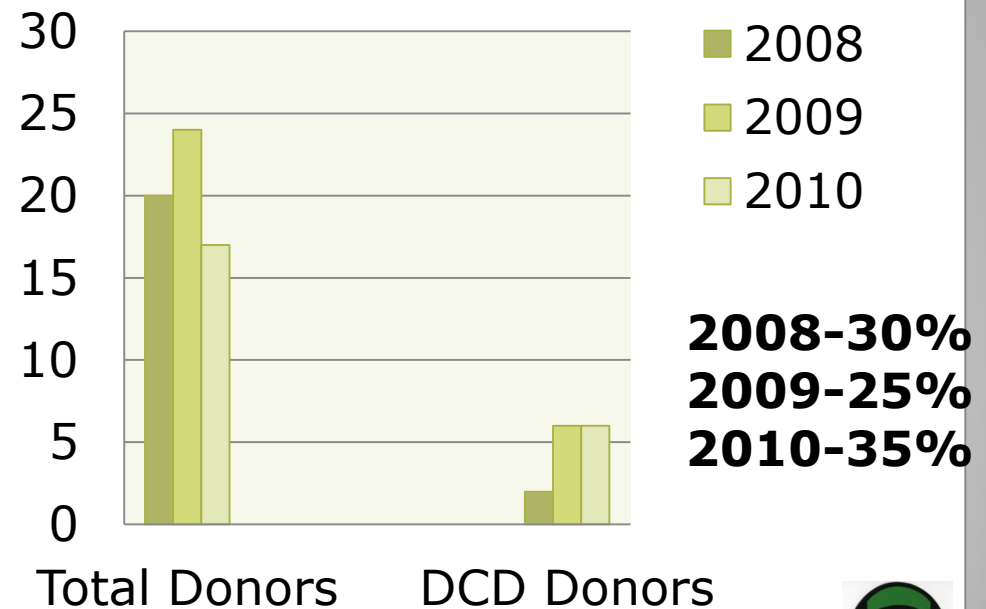


Discuss case studies of how we have been able to positively impact patients families and give them meaningful lifelong memories of their loved ones, while giving the gift of life.
